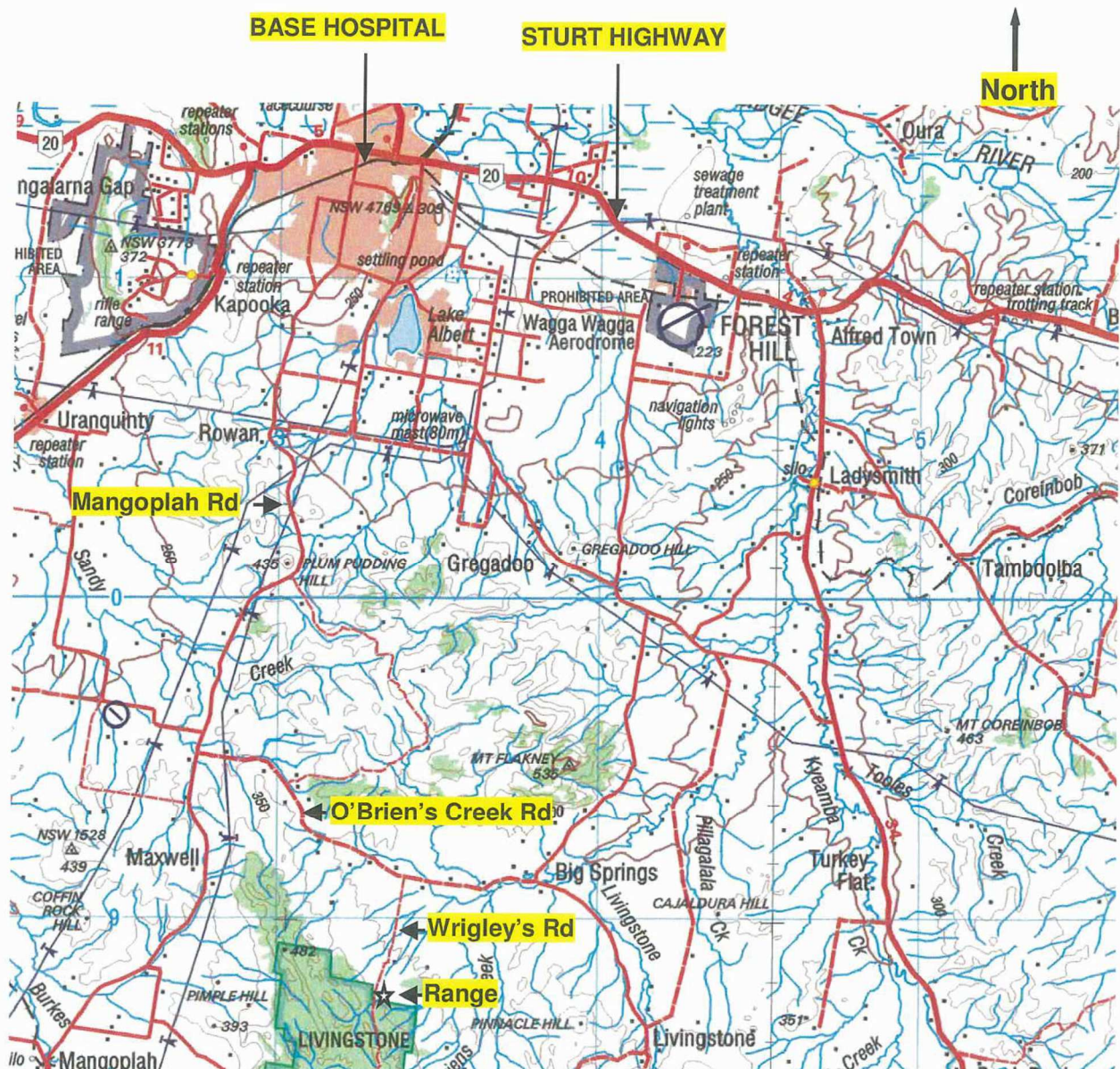
INTRODUCTION

The focus of the day's shoot is to recognize the sacrifice made by men and women of the Australian Armed Forces who served their country in all wars, and to celebrate the legend of the ANZAC's and their Lee Enfield Rifles.

So join us in a fun days shooting and bring your spirit of competition with you.

1. Rifles are to be Lee Enfields in .303 cal as issued any mark can compete from WW1 to the 1950's. Iron service sights only no aperture sights (range sights). Heavy barrels and Number 4's will be accepted if that's the only rifle you have.
2. Ammunition. Due to the difficulty in sourcing of and the reliability of ex-military ammunition, competitors will need to supply their own ammo for the shoot.
3. Medals will be presented on the day for 1st, 2nd and 3rd. This will be the 3 best total scores. A perpetual trophy has been donated by Deb and Greg Hannon from The Wagga Restoration Centre and will be awarded to the shooter taking 1st place, their name will be engraved and placed on the trophy, and kept by the recipient for one year and returned for the next years shoot (suggestions will be sought as to displaying this trophy in the new club rooms upon their completion)
4. As the offhand / pistol range is currently closed the shoot will be shot from the benches.
5. 10 shots at 50y, 10 shots at 100y and 10 shots at 200y.

HOW TO FIND SSAA BIG SPRINGS RIFLE RANGE



Turn south into Bourke Street at the Wagga Base Hospital intersection.

Follow Bourke Street (south) to the roundabout at Red Hill Road.

Go straight through this roundabout, approximately 900 metres past the roundabout you will come to a Tee intersection, turn left, and you are now on the Mangoplah Road.

Follow the Mangoplah road (south) until you are approximately 21 kMs from the Base Hospital intersection.

Turn Left into O'Briens Creek Road.

Follow O'Briens Creek Road for approximately 6 kMs and Turn right into Wrigleys Road.

Follow Wrigley's Road for approximately 3 kMs and you will see the range on your left.
